Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy describes Our policies and procedures regarding the collection, use and disclosure of your information when you use the Service via the Company's website or mobile application, and tells you about your privacy rights and how the law protects you.

We use your Personal Data to provide and improve the Service. By using the Service, you consent to the collection and use of information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

Interpretation and definitions

Interpretation

Words in which the initial letter is capitalized have a meaning defined under the following conditions. The following definitions have the same meaning regardless of whether they are in the singular or plural.

Definitions

For the purposes of this Privacy Policy:

- **Account** means a unique account created for you to access our Service or portions thereof. our Service or portions thereof.
- **Affiliated** person means a legal entity that controls, is controlled by, is controlled by or is under common control with a party, where "control" means the ownership of 50 per cent. or more of the shares, interests or other securities entitled to vote in the election of directors or other governing bodies.
- **Company** (referred to in this Agreement as "Company", "We", "Us" or "Our") refers to Caribbean CAGE LLC and any of its subsidiaries or affiliates (known as the CAGE Companies) .
- **Files cookie** - are small files placed by a website on your computer, mobile device or any other device that contains information about your browsing history on that website among the many uses of the website.
- **Country** relates to: United States, Antigua and Barbuda, Barbados, Guyana, St. Kitts and Nevis, or St. Lucia.
- **Device** means any device that can access the Service, such as a computer, mobile phone or digital tablet.
- **Personal data** - is any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person.
- **Service** refers to the Website, the BetCAGESports online and/or mobile application.

- **Service provider** means any natural or legal person who processes data on behalf of the Company. data on behalf of the Company. This refers to third party companies or individuals employed by the Company to facilitate the Service, to provide the Service on behalf of the Company, to provide services related to the Service, or to assist the Company in analyzing how the Service is the Service is used.
- **Under a third-party social media service** means any website or any social networking website through which the User can log in or create an account. through which the User can log in or create an account to use the Service. account to use the Service.
- **Usage data** - is automatically collected data generated either when using the Service or from the Service infrastructure itself. using the Service or from the Service infrastructure itself (for example, the duration of a page visit).

- **You** means a natural person accessing or using the Service, or a company or other legal entity or individual accessing or using the Service, or the company or other legal entity on whose behalf such individual accesses or uses the Service. on behalf of which such individual accesses or uses the Service, as applicable. use the Service, as applicable.

Collection and use of your personal data

Types of data to be collected

Personal data

When you use our Service, we may ask you to provide us with certain personal information that may be used to to contact or identify you. Personal information may include, but not limited to:

Usage data

Usage data is collected automatically when you use Service.

Usage data may include information such as the Internet Protocol address of your device (e.g., IP address), the type of browser, browser version, the pages of our Service that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time you spend on those pages, your unique device, identifiers that identify you on our Service.

When you access the Service from or through a mobile device mobile device, we may automatically collect certain information, including, but not limited to, the type of mobile device you are using, the unique identifier of your mobile device, the IP address of your mobile device, your mobile operating

system, the type of mobile internet browser that you use, unique device identifiers, and other diagnostic data.

We may also collect information that your browser sends to us whenever you visit our Service or when you access the Service on or through a mobile device.

Information from third-party social networks

Use of your personal data

The Company may use Personal Data for the following purposes:

- **To provide and maintain our Service**, including monitoring the use of our Service.
- **To manage your Account:** to manage your registration as a user of the Service. The Personal Information you provide may give you access to various features of the Service that are available to you as a registered user. registered user.
- **To fulfill the contract:** drafting, honoring and entering a contract for the sale of products, items or services that You have purchased, or any other contract with Us through the Service.

- **To transfer the business:** We may use your information to evaluate or carry out merger, separation, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution or other sale or transfer of some or all of Our assets, whether as a going concern or as part of a bankruptcy. as a going concern or as part of a bankruptcy, liquidation, dissolution, or similar proceedings in which Personal data held by Us about users of Our Service is among the assets transferred.
- **For other purposes:** We may use your information for other purposes, such as analyzing data, identifying usage trends, determining the analyzing data, identifying usage trends, determining the effectiveness of our promotional campaigns, and to evaluate and improve our Service, products, services, marketing and your experience.

We may share your personal information in the following situations:

Storing your personal data

The Company will also retain Usage Data for the purposes of internal analysis. Usage Data will generally be retained for a for a shorter period of time, except when this data is used to enhance the security or improve the functionality of Our Service, or where we are required by law to retain this data for longer periods of time.

Transfer of your personal data

Your information, including Personal Data, is processed at the Company's operational offices and at any other locations where there are parties involved in the processing. This means that this information may be transferred to and stored on computers located outside of outside your state, province, country or other governmental jurisdictions where data protection laws may differ from those in your jurisdiction. your jurisdiction.

Delete your personal data

Disclosure of your personal data

If we become aware that we have collected Personal Information from anyone under the established ages without verifying parental consent, we will take steps to delete that information from our servers.

If we need to rely on consent as a legal basis for processing your information and your country requires parental consent, we may require your parent's consent., we may require your parent's consent, before collecting and using that information.
